### Protocol Refresher

On pages 42-45 are several SHRINE PROTOCOL items that all Nobles should become familiar with or, at least take-a-look at once again. In doing so, it will help to minimize confusion and add to the overall fluid flow of meetings, parades, and events. The guidelines are prepared by the International Shrine and serve as a reminder of how to act, what to do, how to salute, parade rules & regulations, proper Fez care and how to improve the overall appearance and procedures of our Temple, and as Nobles. Here are a few of items for enlightenment:

1) Page 44 - RED FEZ -says, "The Fez is not a display Case or bulletin board". It states that, a Fez should be worn in its proper shape without crushing, creasing or alteration and no device, ornament, title, wording or adornment other than allowed by Article 13 of the bylaws of the International Shrine shall be permitted. *No more than two pins or clasps, without additional embellishments may be used to secure the tassel in place. (No other pins shall be worn on the Fez)*

2) Page 44- Shrine Pins are to be worn on the Left lapel of a suit coat or jacket, Every Noble is encouraged to wear his Shrine pin when so attired. It proudly identifies him as a Shriner to other Nobles, to Freemasons and to the public. A Shrine pin may be worn at non-shrine events as well as Shrine events.

3) Page 43- Order of Speaking- Look at this since this applies to Temple meetings as well as Club or Unit Meetings and can sometimes be easily overlooked.

4) Page 45 - Parade Rules & Regulations- no unit may participate in a parade as a Shrine Unit without first obtaining permission from the Potentate of Za-Ga-Zig Shrine Temple (this can be done in writing, so a record is on file). When a Shrine unit is in a public parade and there is only one (1) Shrine Unit participating, your position in the line of parade is irrelevant. If there is more than one Shrine unit in a public parade, then their position in the lineup of the parade MUST BE TOGETHER. THEY CAN NOT BE SEPERATED!

Pride and the respect in being a Shriner is important to all of us, and by working together with these guidelines, we can assure that Za-Ga-Zig will continue as a leader in the Masonic community, the local community, as well as with Shriner's International. Za-Ga-Zig Shrine Masons truly make a difference!

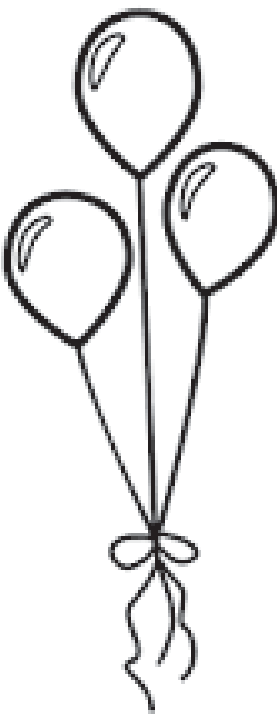
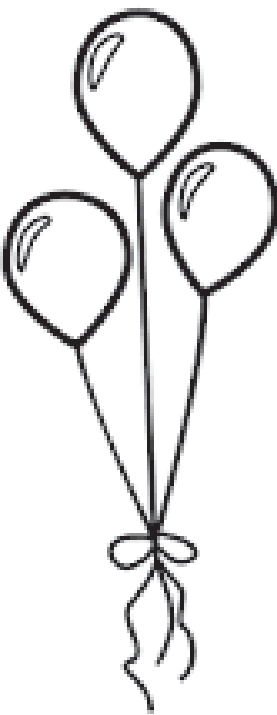
