## Illustrious Sirs and Nobles All

Your Elected Divan and Elected Finance Committee has met on several occasions to review the financial condition and future of the Za Ga Zig Shrine. As reported by Vice Chair Palmitier, expenditures were reviewed and are constantly under review as we move forward. With reductions over the past 16 months, we see an improvement of operating expenses and will continue to try and reduce costs, with a minimum of impact of services, activities and programming.

Where we have seen the most direct financial impact is in income. A continuing decline in membership, advertising dollars, rentals, overall fundraising monies and a decline in Unit and Club donations severely impact the bottom line. Most importantly is the overall decline in membership participation in fundraising activities. In order to fund Za Ga Zig, 70% of funds come from fundraising efforts. For example, approximately 35% of Nobles purchase their Circus Tickets, which is our single largest fundraiser. We need your help. Consideration has been given to moving charitable fundraising efforts to fraternal side of the balance sheet.

When the 2020 Budget Committee met, formulated and presented the 2020 Budget it was with new ideas and hopes of greater participation, ideas and passion in our fraternity. Goals were realistic and reductions were manageable, as seen by the Units and Clubs help with Nobility Ball room charges, for example. We needed help and the Nobility stepped up to the mission. We are asking for your help again.

A proposal will be presented to the Nobility, **May 5th** and voted on at the **June 9th** Stated Meeting. This proposal was deliberated and debated by the Finance Committee and Elected Divan. Those present at the last meeting agreed on proposing to the Nobility, starting in 2021, to increase the annual dues to \$200.00 per regular member. This increase includes the Annual Hospital Assessment and Per Captita, as assessed by Imperial, of 35.00. As we move forward, if Imperial raises the Hospital Assessment or Per Captita, so too will your contribution increase. 

*Flag etiquette* \* When the United States flag passes in revue, the Pledge of Allegiance or the National Anthem is presented, all those present should stand at attention and salute the flag, whether indoors (i.e. a ceremonial or Potentate's Ball) or outdoors (i.e. a parade) when the colors are within six paces. All Nobles wearing a Fez should give the military salute with their right hand and should not remove their Fez. If in civilian clothing, the right hand should be placed over the heart. If men are wearing a hat, the head cover should be removed. For Nobles wearing a Fez, whether in uniform or not, the Fez should remain in place and the military salute should be given. The salute should be held until the Pledge of Allegiance and/or National Anthem is completed, the colors are posted, or the colors have passed.

During a prayer, a Noble wearing a Fez should remove it and hold it over his head in an upright position with the name of the Temple facing the front.
