Potentate's Comments

Welcome to the middle of 2020! I want to reach out and thank every Past Potentate, Noble, Lady and friend that has offered words of encouragement as we navigate through pandemics, civil unrest and the passing of Nobles and dear friends.

Za Ga Zig has been devastated with the recent loss of Nobles and I ask, that as you read this, take a moment and remember all who have been called by the Great Architect of the Universe. We pray for their families and share in their memories.

May and June were turning points for Za Ga Zig and we look forward to making Za Ga Zig financially strong. In the following pages you will find some of the strategies we have put into place to ease the burden on the Nobility. Asst. Rabban Randy Weldon will be introducing some additional incentives also. Current we have set up a recurring payment system that Nobles can break down their dues payments in segments, at your choice and have it automatically deducted from a designated account. This system is used by Imperial and a number of Shrine Centers are using the service. I know there was sticker shock, we get it however, if you break it down to a monthly amount it is less than 20.00 a month to belong to the greatest Fraternity in the world. We are committed to working for the betterment of the Shrine.

A dues increase is not the cure and it does not eliminate the need for fundraising for the General Fund. 2021 will continue to present new challenges to the Nobility and leadership.

We are working on opening up the Shrine Center, we are monitoring the requirements and capacity guidelines, and our sole concern is for the safety of our members and guest. It will require added sanitation and adhering to recommendations by the State. Opening up comes with an additional cost as supplies are limited and the need for volunteers to assist in the decontamination. If we do not have the necessary help to clean and disinfect the facility it will limit our ability to open. I am asking units and clubs who regularly meet at the Shrine Center to help with this task. We do not have employees to perform these tasks.

As we open up for regular Stated Meetings, there are capacity limitations, we currently could accommodate approximately 150 Nobles at a meeting. We also realize that some may not feel comfortable or safe in attending meetings. We will continue to use the Zoom application to allow more Nobles to participate and help reduce travel. I encourage each of you to participate and become part of the decision making process.

Finally, in order for Za Ga Zig to recover from a devastating year we need every Noble to participate. The future of Za Ga Zig is in our hands.

Dues Update

We want to be as clear as possible to the Nobility about the approved dues increase and Life Member Status.

First, Life member Status and rates are dictated by Imperial. They have a minimum amount that we can assess for Life Dues and a maximum that can be assessed by a Temple. Since we have taken no action to change the requirements I want to outline them so everyone is clear. Here are the formulas.

If you are under 65, currently the Life Dues are as follows.

20 X 65.00 = 1300.00 Za Ga Zig Shrine Dues

30 X 30.00 = 900.00 Imperial Per Capita

30 X 5.00 = 150.00 Annual Hospital Assessment

If you pay all three, the total is 2350.00. You may pay one, two or three. However, if you only choose to pay the Za Ga Zig dues you are still responsible for the Annual Per Capita and Hospital Assessment and you will be billed annually for those items.

If you are 65 or older, currently the Life Dues are as follows.

10 X 65.00 = 650.00 Za Ga Zig Shrine Dues

30 X 30.00 = 900.00 Imperial Per Capita

30 X 5.00 = 150.00 Annual Hospital Assessment

If you pay all three, the total is 1700.00. You may pay one, two or three. However, if you only choose to pay the Za Ga Zig dues you are still responsible for the Annual Per Capita and Hospital Assessment and you will be billed annually for those items.

The above tables are good until October 1, 2020 when the new dues notices will be sent out. At that time, new tables will be created reflecting the dues increase that was just voted in by the membership.

In addition, we spoke about a system that allows you to setup a monthly payment plan so you don't have to pay the full \$200.00 at once. You can access WebFez at <https://webfez.shrinenet.org/> to access your information. You will be required to have your dues card to provide your membership number. Once you have created your login, you will go to a main page. On this page, Click on the icon that says My Record. At the top of the page that opens will be a link to Set up Payment Plan. When you click on that button, you can set up a plan to pay your dues Quarterly, Monthly, or Yearly. It will then ask for your information to make the payments. You must be current on your dues for this to work.

• Fast Track Video Visits: Virtual clinic appointments are available for existing and new patients with Shriners Children's providers. Patients are able to connect with us from the safety of their home through their phone, tablet or computer.

• COVID-19 Coronavirus Response: We had previously asked patients to reschedule non-urgent appointments. We are now able to welcome back into the clinic, with the following restrictions based on CDC patient safety guidelines. Included with this letter you will find transportation guidelines for Shrine Drivers.

• If you or the patient and family you are transporting have had flu-like symptoms, sore throat, shortness of breath, sudden loss of taste or smell, or come in contact with someone who is positive for COVID-19 within the past 2 weeks, please contact our staff before coming to your scheduled appointment.

• Everyone entering our building is screened for COVID-19 symptoms, including reading their temperature.

• Only the patient and one guardian will be allowed in the building, as well as in Shrine transportation vehicles.

• Social distancing of 6 feet or more must be maintained.

• All visitors over 2 years of age are required to arrive wearing a mask. If you arrive without a mask, we have some available for your use.

Outreach Clinics: We hope to resume our outreach clinics this summer and will communicate our plans as they develop.

Camps & Events: All camps and events scheduled for July have been cancelled.

Brother Nobles, what a strange couple of months that we have gone through. Unfortunately we have lost some great members to this Covid. But we are still here and need to carry on for their memory.

The 2021 Dues will increase to \$200.00 (\$165.00 Temple Dues, \$30.00 Imperial Per Capita and \$5.00 Imperial Hospital Assessment). I want all members to know their options. First off by this writing we still have 145 members that have not paid there 2020 Dues. Please Brothers if you have a problem or need assistance reach out to any of the Elected Divan for help. We do not want to lose anyone. You joined your Masonic Lodge and the Shrine for a great reason.

If you are under 65 you can have a Lifetime Dues Membership in Za-Ga-Zig for \$1,300.00. If you want to have Lifetime Imperial Per Capita you would owe \$900.00 and if you want to have Lifetime Hospital Assessment you would owe \$150.00. You can pay all three for a total of \$2,350.00 OR you can pay any one of the three. If you are over 65 your Za-Ga-Zig Lifetime Dues Membership in Za-Ga-Zig would be \$650.00. The other Imperial Per Capita and Hospital Assessment remain the same.
