Words from Oriental Guide

Robert "Clif" Coker



I was first introduced to the book, *Who Moved My Cheese*, back in 2007, when I managed the facility department of a large retailer's call center. I was given the book and I placed it on the shelf in my office, not reading it immediately.

In 2012, I was the Worshipful Master, of my home lodge in Arkansas, and was confronted by the older members, of why I was wanting to make a change. I kept being told, "this is the way things have been for over forty years and they do not need to change." This made me think of all the changes I had seen in the last 40 years of my life, and I could not imagine where I would be if I

did not embrace change. It was at that point I took the book, *Who Moved My Cheese*, off the shelf in my office and read it, and it was then that I started to reflect on what happened in my life and the world 40 years before 2012.

In 1972, 40 years prior to 2012 was the beginning of the Watergate Scandal, NASA introduced the Space Shuttle program, last of the US ground troops were withdrawn from Vietnam and "The Godfather" was released.

In 1976, we celebrated the Bicentennial of The United States, Viking 1 landed on Mars, Jimmy Carter was elected President of the United States, "Rocky" premiered, CN Tower in Toronto was complete and became the tallest free-standing structure in the world. Oh, and I almost forgot to mention, Apple was formed and is now one of the largest tech companies in the world and was the first USA company worth over \$2 trillion.

Let's jump to 1980, The Iran-Iraq war began, the USA defeats the Soviet Union in ice hockey at the Winter Olympics, millions of viewers tuned in to see who shot J.R. Ewing, and Ronald Regan was elected President.

In 1986, I earned and was awarded the Boy Scouts of America Eagle Scout award, Challenger disintegrated after being launched, Mike Tyson was the youngest heavyweight champion, and smoking was banned on all public transport. In 1990, the Hubble Space Telescope was launched, demolition of the Berlin Wall and Operation Desert Shield began, and *The Simpsons* aired on TV.

In 1991, my daughter was born, the USA and Soviet Union signed the START Treaty, five people were killed in a shooting rampage at the University of Iowa, and the Dow Jones average topped 3,000 for the first time.

In the year 2000, we had the infamous Y2K scare, the first internal space crew arrived in space, Tiger Woods became the youngest player to win Grand Slam in golf, and the final Peanuts comic strip was published.

In 2006, I moved to Arkansas to start a career in retail, after being a police officer and petroleum service engineer, NASA launched the New Horizons probe, North Korea carried out its first test of a nuclear weapon, and Saddam Hussein was charged with crimes against humanity.

In 2008, I was raised as a Master Mason, the first African American man was elected President of the United States, the United States' financial system collapsed, we had the resurgence of the Taliban in Afghanistan, and Fidel Castro stepped down as president of Cuba.

In 2011, NASA launched Juno, Osama bin Laden was killed, North Korea proposed peace talks with South Korea, and Japan was struck by one of the most powerful earthquakes, in history. The year 2012, brought a major change in my life. After dating for two years, I married Donna. I am a lucky guy!

With the year 2021, half over, I ask you to look back over your last 10, 20, 30, or 40 years and imagine not dealing with the change in life, and where you would be now. *Who Moved My Cheese* tells a story, which we can directly apply to our own lives, as Nobles, to stop fearing what lies ahead, but instead succeed in a world of change and uncertainty.
