As healthcare has evolved from inpatient care to outpatient-focused models of care, we have already transitioned several of our locations to outpatient care models. In Florida, we have started transitioning portions of our care to local and state affiliates who complement our services locally and throughout the state.

Part of this future state includes the transition of services at the Shriners Children's facility on the USF campus in Tampa, Florida. The planned transition of clinical services is underway, and started April 1, 2022, and will thereafter be sequenced over the next several months as we redistribute services to better align with emerging models of care. Our priority at this time is to ensure a smooth transition for all of our patients and employees.

Locally, we are working diligently on a potential care pathway to maintain a level of specialized care in the Tampa Bay region, hoping to continue our proud service here as it has been for over 35 years. Information on this potential local care path will be available soon.

The Shriners Children's healthcare system will remain headquartered in Tampa, as it has been for more than 40 years, and the Shriners Children's Genomics Institute will continue its important work at its current location on the USF campus.

We appreciate your trust and support as we continue to adapt and strengthen our health care system to meet the needs of today and the future.

Greetings Fraternal Members of Shriners Children's Twin Cities!

Wow, what a first quarter we experienced in the Twin Cities market. Foundationally, we have stated to gain traction in how our ambulatory care clinic model is expected to operate. We have been deep in discussions with other organizations to identify how we can further collaborate in our markets to serve more children and spread our presence to align with Vision 2035. This includes getting back to our outreach location on a more regular schedule, partnering with new organizations across the market and deepening relationships with existing organizations.

Operationally, we still have challenges burdened by outdated bylaws that we need to change if we want to remain relevant and true to our mission of serving all children with the best care anywhere regardless of means to pay. This includes those children who have the financial means either independently or with insurances who want to come to Shriners Children's. Unfortunately the stigma of we only serve "free kids" is still alive and we either have children not coming here because we are not in network with their payer or are those with financial means to pay as a self-pay but do not like to be identified as "charitable" and get free care. The beauty of our system is that we can serve all who can and want to pay or cannot pay. This is the differentiator that addresses healthcare disparity.

Clinically, we have started to add services back that had dwindled during the past several years due to market dynamics and the transition we made to an ambulatory care clinic. Some of these services are cranial facial services that will initially address plagiocephaly and in the future provide surgical care for cleft lip and pallet, as well as, we are updating our ultrasound so we can do needle guided steroidal injections and we have received final approval to install our sensory space therapy equipment. Lastly, by the end of April we hope to expand services for direct community referrals to therapy (this is huge).

Finally, we are breathing a little more freely with a lighter mandatory mask policy for nobe clinic/patient facing spaces. Our staff loves it! The past two years have been extremely challenging with COVID and the various aspects of wearing masks, distancing and vaccinations. The good news is that we have "weathered the worst of the storm" for now, our staff have shown exceptional resiliency and we have shown that we can do anything as a team! I personally could not be prouder of the team we have working at Shriners Children's Twin Cities.

For now, thank you for all you do as the fraternal partners in helping Shriners Children's be the preeminent pediatric orthopedic organization in the world!
