Proposed By-Law Change

Craig Matzke, 2019 Chief Rabban

Nobles, on July 9, 2019, I offered a proposal to change the Za Ga Zig Shrine By-Laws. The reader's digest version is that we will change Article 7 Subsection 7.3 Finance Advisory Committee to a permanent committee and change the composition of the committee. The change in the composition will add four ex-officio members to include the Treasurer, Junior Past Potentate, Potentate and Chief Rabban.

The other four positions on the committee will remain elected by the Nobility. The change in composition is offered to provide real time information and feedback to the committee and Divan. It is our intent to create a collaborative environment to better serve the Nobility.

This item will be presented for a **re-vote** at the next regularly scheduled Stated Meeting on July 12, 2022.
