We have also cancelled the Rocky Horror Picture Show Drive In. Look for a replacement event for this as well.



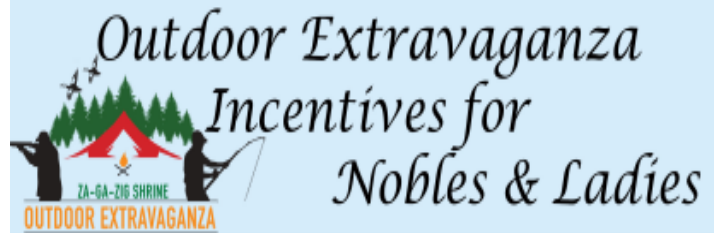
