Marvel Comic's Spider-Man superhero makes his first appearance in a comic book, the Space Needle observation tower in Seattle is completed and there was a riot on the University of Mississippi campus following black student James Meredith's attempt to enroll in classes.

Samsar Report

On January 1, 2023 we started the year with 1002 nobles of Za-Ga-Zig Shrine. As of May 10th, we created 10 new nobles, affiliated 2, restored 14 suspended nobles (recall we had to suspend 64 nobles at the end of 2022-so far have 14 of them back) for a total of 1015. We are at a net gain of 13 nobles for the year. We can, and must, do better.

Looking a bit deeper into the numbers- 10 creations and 14 restorations = 24 nobles over a 4-month time span. This is an average of 6 nobles a month. We can, and must, do better.

As of May 10th, we have lost 13 nobles to the Black Camel.

We have 1 ePetition in WebFez that I am working, 6 Master Masons who have expressed an interest in continuing their journey, and 39 prospects. According to WebFez, we now have a 38.46% conversion rate with our prospects. We can, and must, do better.

The mini ceremonials are working! Think about it- we are offering those individuals 12 opportunities a year to join. Every month on the 4th Tuesday of the month we offer our masonic brothers an opportunity to become a Shriner. Look for these future nobles. They are out theremany are just waiting to be asked.

If anyone is interested in assisting with the ritual, please reach out to our 1st or 2nd Ceremonial Masters. There are occasions where someone will not be available and we will need a stand-in.



Remembering the Past Looking Toward A NEW HORIZON 100 Years 1923-2023

WGA 4 Kids Board Celebrated 100 Years at its Annual Meeting

Our 100th Anniversary celebration April 21 & 22, 2023 is over. Who knew back in 1923 when the WGA Board started with a small group of women from the Osman and Zuhrah Shrine Centers, that 100 years later we would still be here and thriving. Those ladies, in turn, recruited other interested ladies from Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wisconsin, Iowa, and Minnesota encouraging them to start auxiliaries in their areas. Of course the purpose of the annual meeting is seeing old friends and making some new friends, but also to hear from some of the people who work with our children, hear how the medical field is improving the lives of the children and most importantly to give the auxiliaries a chance to share ideas on how to increase membership and fundraising. Our speakers were fantastic as usual. Our wheelchair provider, Rehabilitation Designs Inc., better known to us as RDI presented a program called "Our Kids" showing children from 1986 to the present with photos and interviews. They have partnered with WGA 4 Kids for over 30 years. For their dedication to our cause, all these years, a lovely plaque was presented to them by Elizabeth Ekholm Monday morning following their presentation. After a wonderful lunch, Mary Rose, a former physical therapist provided us with a fascinating history on how physical therapies for the children has changed over the years. She worked as a Physical Therapist at Shriners from 1985 to 2020.

The day concluded with a banquet on Monday evening. The guest speakers were Dr. Chris Vara, a surgeon for Shriners Children's, who spoke about the current treatments for our kids. Daryl Finley, Chairman, Board of Governors, after greeting the attendees, he presented a Proclamation from Shriners International to the WGA 4 Kids Board acknowledging our work over the past 100 years. For everyone to view and enjoy during the annual meeting a history of the Auxiliary was put together with pictures dating back to the beginning of our hospital in 1923. It was fun to see some of the children that were treated back then and to view the original hospital buildings. I found the pictures of the cars that were driven back in 1923 fascinating. How times have changed. For all who missed this year's event we sincerely hope you will be with us next year.
