# Blast From the Past

The year was 1939. The outbreak of WWII happened on September 1<sup>st</sup>. Hitler invaded Poland from the west and 48 hours later, France and Britain declared war on Germany. Soviet troops invaded from the east on September 17<sup>th</sup>. On November 4<sup>th</sup> President Roosevelt signs the Neutrality Act of 1939 into law. The arms embargo previously put into place by the Neutrality Act of 1937 is lifted and put any trade with nations engaged in war under "cash-and-carry" terms.

Albert Einstein and President Roosevelt begin the America atomic bomb program known today as the Manhattan Project. Eugene Weidmann was the last person publicly executed by guillotine in France. Emelia Earhart is officially declared dead, 18 months after her disappearance.

A dark year indeed, so let's lighten it up! The 1939 World's Fair opened in New York on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The first Thin Mint cookies were baked by the Girl Scouts. Founded by Carl Stotz, the first Little League Baseball game was played in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. Popular songs were *Over the Rainbow* (Julie Garland) and *God Bless America* (Kate Smith.) Lou Gehrig was probably the most famous person in America at the time. Movies to watch were The Wizard of Oz, Gone with the Wind, Mister Smith Goes to Washington, The Son of Frankenstein, Destiny Rides and Stagecoach.

In 1939, Omaha hosted a Central States Shrine Regional Ceremonial. 16 temples and their uniform bodies from Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, Nebraska and Oklahoma joined Tangier Temple of Omaha in celebration. Every candidate's trip and expenses were paid for by the shrine and every Noble whose named appeared on the top line of a petition also earned this trip with all expenses paid. Our Potentate, Mark Conkling, arranged a special train consisting of "Deluxe Air-Conditioned Coaches" at a rate of \$3.00 per person round trip. The Hotel Fontanelle was Za-Ga-Zig's headquarter hotel.

Although this was strictly a STAG TRAIN, arrangements were made for special coaches for shrine ladies leaving from Des Moines  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour after the Nobles departed for Omaha.


