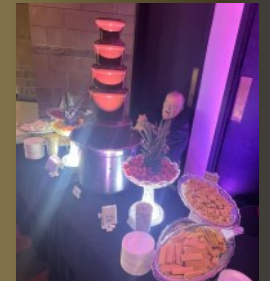

# Fall Ceremonial Honoree

It is my honor to select Noble Cleon Babcock as our 2023 Fall Ceremonial Honoree.

Cleon grew up in the small Iowa town of Farnhamville with a population of 400. In high school, he played basketball and baseball. In his junior year, the superintendent had him coach the junior high school basketball team. didn't play much the first half of the basketball season, but played all of the games the second half and was next to high point for the season. As a senior he played baseball and was a pitcher and he played first base. He graduated in 1947.

Cleon was elected to his church board at age 21. He was also a Scoutmaster and sent all of the scouts to camp even though some required financial assistance.

After high school, his minister talked him into becoming a basketball official. He officiated games in Iowa, Florida, Japan, and North Dakota. The last three were when he was in the military.

He married Lady Jean in 1949. They were both 19. Many didn't think it would last, but they were together for 69 years, before she passed away. They had one son, Jeff, who is a Mason and Shriner.

He joined the U.S. Air Force 1 day before his draft notice was sent. He was a cryptographer, putting messages in and out of code, and attained the rank of S/Sgt. before being honorably discharged.

After his military service he used the GI Bill to go to college. He attended Drake University where he earned a BS in Business Administration in 3 years. Upon graduating he worked as a casualty claim adjuster for 12 years. Then he worked for the Iowa Public Safety Department where he was the Director of Motor Vehicle Division. When that division became part of the Department of Transportation, he left and became a Safety Inspector for Farmland Insurance for 23 years.

When he was living in Creston, his minister suggested that he join Toastmasters International. He was about to be elected as President of that club when he was appointed Area Governor. He served in that position for 2 years. He was then elected as Lt. Governor of District 19 (State of Iowa). During that time, he met the founder of AIP (American Institute of Parliamentarians). Later he joined that organization and earned his CPP (Certified Professional Parliamentarian). He was elected to the international board, where he served for 28 years. He served 2 terms as President. He has served as Parliamentarian for international organizations. Currently he serves as Parliamentarian for Polk and Dallas County Republican Central Committees, COAI (Clowns of America International) and Za-Ga-Zig Shrine. In 1989, Potentate Dick Heiken appointed him Parliamentarian and as he has served in that position ever since. In 2020, Potentate Craig Matzke awarded him Parliamentarian Emeritus.

When talking with some friends from Toastmasters, he learned that they were Master Masons. He asked them why they never invited him to be a Mason. Shortly after that, he began his Mason journey in January 1970 at Pioneer Lodge 222. A few years later he was the Junior Warden. He gave up that position because he traveled a lot with his job and was away from home 3 to 4 nights each week and thought that his family should come first.

In 1995 he retired and became active once again in the Masons and was appointed Sr. Steward. The following year he was elected Junior Warden and in 2 years he became Worshipful Master. He was elected Master of his Lodge 6 times. He says they kept electing him until he got it right. He has served every office in the Lodge except Treasurer and Marshal. He is currently serving as Tyler.

In the spring of 1970, he joined the Scottish Rite and achieved his 32<sup>nd</sup> degree. December of that same year he walked the Hot Sands of the Shrine at the KRNT Theater. It was the next to last class to walk the Hot Sands at that location. Cleon is a member of the Mobile Nobles. He has helped as a golf cart driver for many years. He also works at all of the Shrine Circus performances. He was asked to fill a Trustee position when the person who had been elected only served one month and then moved out of the state. He agreed, however, at the end of that year he ran for a full term. He was elected two more times. He was a Trustee when the Temple was built in Altoona. He is currently serving as High Priest and Prophet.

There is a lot more that I could say about him, but I will end with this. I am honored to have served on the Elected Divan this year with Cleon Babcock.

He has been a real asset to Za-Ga-Zig Shrine.


# Its RAFFLE TIME!!!
