



Finish building store and breaking down pallets of food

set up tables in middle and organize boxes for 100+ families this year

Fill boxes from store around edge of room if time allows

Wednesday Dec 18 morning shift 8 am - 12pm 10 helpers

Coffee and Donuts provided

Fill boxes from store around edge of room

We may get done early this day depending on # of helpers and how things go Monday evening

Lunch provided if things look like we will be there until noon

Thursday Dec 19 morning shift 8 am - 1pm 12 helpers

Coffee and Donuts provided

Hand out the food and toys to the families

Families will check in at the door with the buzzer and we put the food and toys in their cars at the door near the kitchen.

We will need helpers who can lift and are comfortable being outside in cold weather. Bring your coat and gloves.

We will also need a desk person and at least one person who stays inside and organizes carts and fresh food bags


