Happy Spring from your office staff! I wanted to drop a few reminders as we prepare for another busy part of 2026.

We appreciate all your calls and emails as we move towards being more responsive to your inquiries. If you happen to get the answering machine, please leave a message and we will promptly return your calls. It's important to us that we exceed your expectations when you call.

Fundraising Events-We were reminded at CSSA this year of the importance of submitting the Fundraising Approval Request and Fundraiser Financial Report. Forms can be found on our website or can be requested from the office. Requests and Reports must be submitted for all events. Whether it is a recurring event or annual event forms must be submitted for each year.

We were also reminded of the protocol surrounding the marketing and verbiage in the advertisements. We are willing to assist with marketing your event and promoting it on our various platforms. If you would like assistance, we ask for materials or information 60-90 days prior to the event to be most effective.

Parades- As parades season is getting ready to kick off please, remember to send in a copy of your insurance for vehicle and trailer. Ill. Sir. Doug Miller will promptly send out your stickers for your vehicles. We must have insurance on all vehicles.

Another reminder is that we are not allowed to throw candy out at parades. This policy is from Imperial and has been in place for many years, regardless of the policy of the event that we are parading at.

RSVPs. We have implemented using Simpletix for a variety of Temple functions, this helps our Kitchen Staff better prepare for the event and control costs. As always if you would rather call the office, we are always happy to chat with you.

Office Closings- We will do our best to let everyone know when the office will be closed. Typically, we will be closed on National Holidays. In the event we are closed due to inclement weather or illness, we will make notification via our Facebook Nobles and Ladies Page. Additionally, I monitor my email, and I do receive phone message notifications via email. Again, we will respond promptly during normal business hours.

Club and Unit 990s- We are still missing a few 990 Reports from Units and Clubs, please take time to verify yours has been submitted. The Temple incurs penalties for late reports and delays important accounting deadlines.

Insurance – Get a copy of your insurance declaration page to Ill. Sir Doug Miller, PP. to get your parade sticker. **Those without proof of insurance will be unable to participate in parades.**

Sticker – Place the insurance sticker on your parade vehicle. Or always have it with you when you participate in a parade. Take a photo and save where easily accessible and be prepared to show it to the Parade Marshal.

Non-Shriners – In civic parades, and non-Shrine public appearances. Nobles, their ladies, children and masonic related or sponsored organizations may participate, with the approval of the Potentate. Be sure to register your ladies and others if you plan to have them ride along in the parade.

Throwing Objects – No candy or other objects shall be HANDED OUT OR THROWN from any vehicle in the parade. A Shriner may walk along the edge of a parade route and hand out Shrine information.

Alcoholic Beverages – Members of participating units shall not drink any alcoholic beverages before or during any parade.

Shrine Parade Regulations – If you would like a copy of the Shrine Parade Regulations, please see the Parade Marshal or the Potentate.

Thank you to everyone who came out—we loved seeing you all there. Can't wait to do it again soon!

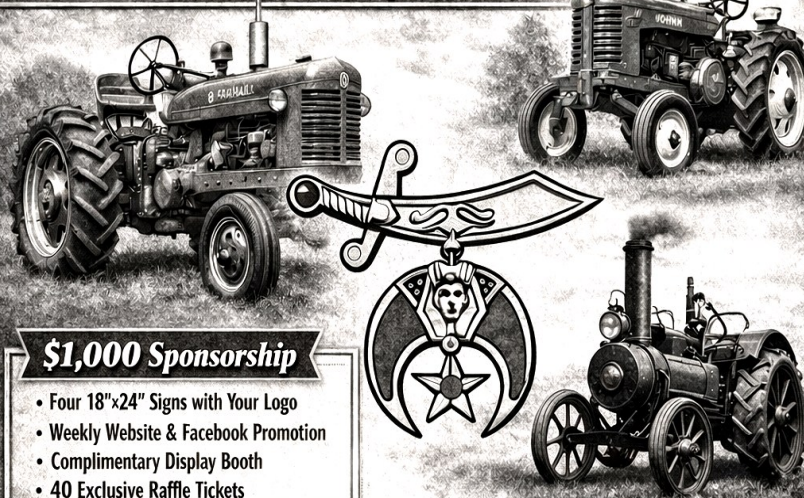

YES, IT IS! Ever since we had our first show in 2023, the proceeds from this show benefited the Za-G-Zig Shrine. The last 3 shows put over \$5000.00 each year into our general fund.

To continue improving on this event, there are several changes being made. First, we are tying this show into an open house. We are opening our doors to the community. We want people to come out and walk around the building and see the display cases, photos and paintings. We want all parade units to bring their parade vehicles to the temple and have them on display for the public to see. We will have members of the masonic bodies on hand to discuss Masonry, the Scottish Rite, York Rite and the Shrine to those who want more information. Attendees can have a free hot dog, popcorn and fountain pop, get in on raffles and watch or participate in contests and games.

Second, and this is one that will benefit your units and clubs, we are paying 25% commissions on all sponsorships sold. Vidalia Onion Pre-Orders Underway

Vidalia onion pre-orders are underway during **March and April**, with the order deadline of April 17th and delivery expected around **May 8th or 9th**, just before Mother's Day.

The price has not changed, we are at the \$13 price point for 10 lbs.

Clubs and units are encouraged to designate an **Onion Chairman** who can collect orders from members and submit **one combined order for the group**. This layered approach spreads the work out and helps keep the process organized.

Members will typically pay their club or unit **\$13 per bag**. The club or unit then submits **one payment to the Temple at \$10.50 per bag**, keeping their commission locally.

To simplify the accounting process, we ask that **one check be submitted from each club or unit whenever possible**, rather than many individual checks. This greatly reduces the financial workload and helps keep the ordering process running smoothly.

A **pre-order worksheet** is available to help Onion Chairmen organize their lists and totals before submitting their unit or club order.

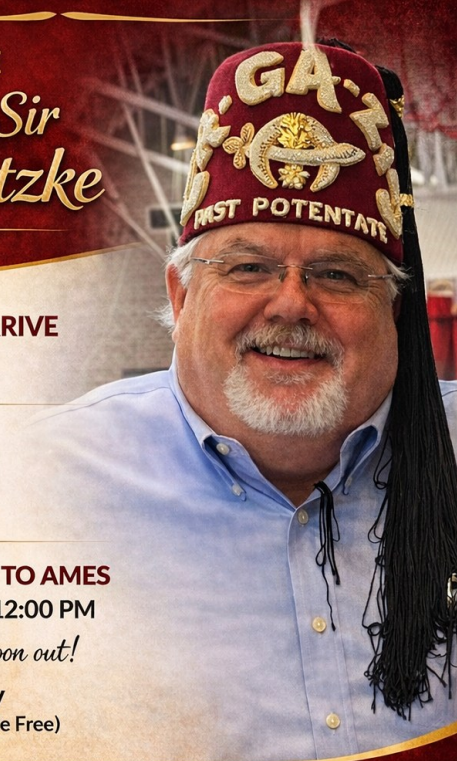
