**Sticker** – Place the insurance sticker on your parade vehicle. Or always have it with you when you participate in a parade. Take a photo and save where easily accessible and be prepared to show it to the Parade Marshal.

**Non-Shriners** – In civic parades, and non-Shrine public appearances. Nobles, their ladies, children and masonic related or sponsored organizations may participate, with the approval of the Potentate. Be sure to register your ladies and others if you plan to have them ride along in the parade.

**Throwing Objects** – No candy or other objects shall be HANDED OUT OR THROWN from any vehicle in the parade. A Shriner may walk along the edge of a parade route and hand out Shrine information.

**Alcoholic Beverages** – Members of participating units shall not drink any alcoholic beverages before or during any parade.

**Shrine Parade Regulations** – If you would like a copy of the Shrine Parade Regulations, please see the Parade Marshal or the Potentate.

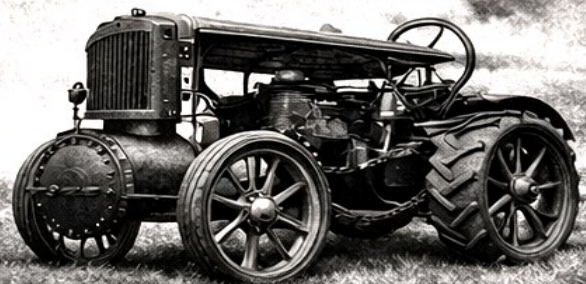
